The programme is meant to provide guidance to candidates who are researchers, or are aspirants for their Ph.D. or M.Phil. studies. While the Programme was originally confined to the discipline of Economics, it will hereafter be applicable to other disciplines as well.

The Programme has been organised by the J.C.Sandesara Centre for Economic Research at ISED. Prof Sandesara was founder Director, Bombay School of Economics and Public Policy, University of Mumbai. Prof. Sandesara was India's towering scholar in the sub discipline of Industrial Economics, who has taught and mentored several doyens in positions of power, such as, Reserve Bank of India, Union and State Ministries, Diplomatic Missions, Universities etc.

The objective of the Programme is to promote young researchers and quality research output in priority areas of research, such as, Entrepreneurship, Small and Medium Enterprises, Local Economic Development, Economic Governance, Responsible Business and Industrial Economics.
