

ISED Releases India MSME Report 2025

India Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Report 2025, the 28th volume of the Institute's prestigious MSMER Series, was released at the ISED International SME Day 2025, held at Cochin on June 20, 2025.

The focal theme of the Report this year is SME value chains and India's 'Viksit Bharat' Agenda. Against the backdrop of the reciprocal tariff crisis, the global SME agenda in 2025 revolves around the thematic issue of Global Value Chains (GVCs). The 'ISED International SME Day 2025', and its deliberations were focused on the intricacies and opportunities around the reciprocal tariff regime and its implications for the sustainability of the MSME constituency.
