



‘Aero-entrepreneurship City’: ISED Model catches up

Development economists and practitioners have debated extensively on the paradigm of ‘port-enclave development’ for long. With the new paradigm of ‘Hubanomics’, just- in -time production, and rapid urbanization, the relevance of ports has come down in the global logistics map; the space has been occupied by airports and airways.
